Support for Aged Care Workers in COVID-19 Grant Opportunity

Applications for the Support for Aged Care Workers in COVID-19 (SACWIC) Grant Opportunity close at **2pm Canberra local time** on 30 June 2022.

The SACWIC grant opportunity reimburses eligible approved providers for eligible out of pocket expenses associated with implementing single site worker arrangements during the eligible COVID-19 hotspots and high-risk locations listed in Appendix 1 of the Grant Opportunity Guidelines.

Examples of eligible workforce costs under SACWIC are those that supported eligible workers:

- who normally work at multiple residential aged care facilities, but worked solely at the facility being applied for during the Activity period;
- who were not to attend work because they had been experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, had been diagnosed as COVID-19 positive, required testing or were subject to self-isolation or quarantine requirements during the Activity period; or
- to undertake training in the event a skills gap arises from where existing workers were not to work due to experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or were subject to self-isolation or quarantine requirements during the Activity period.

Applications for the SACWIC grant opportunity close at **2pm Canberra local time on 30 June 2022.**

You will need to address all eligibility criteria and include all necessary attachments.
